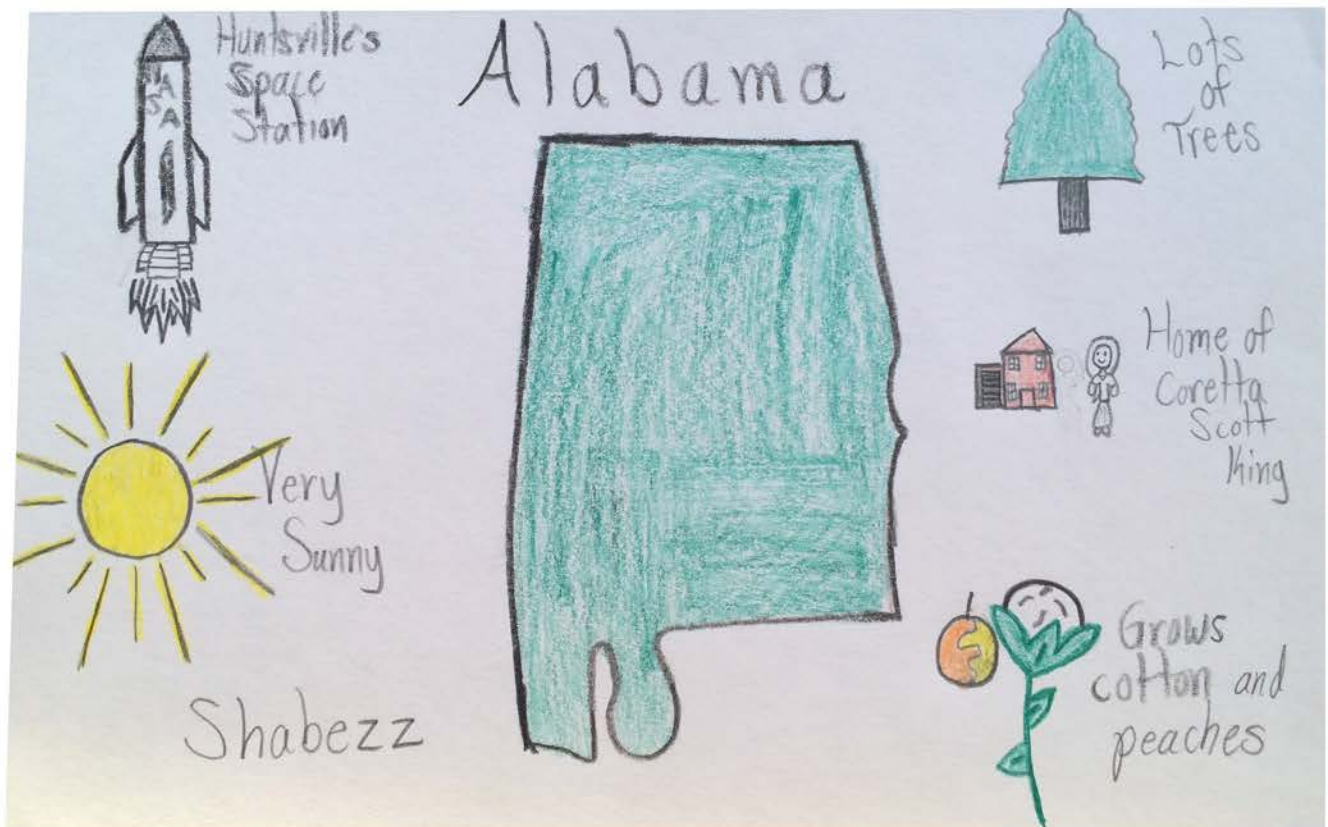
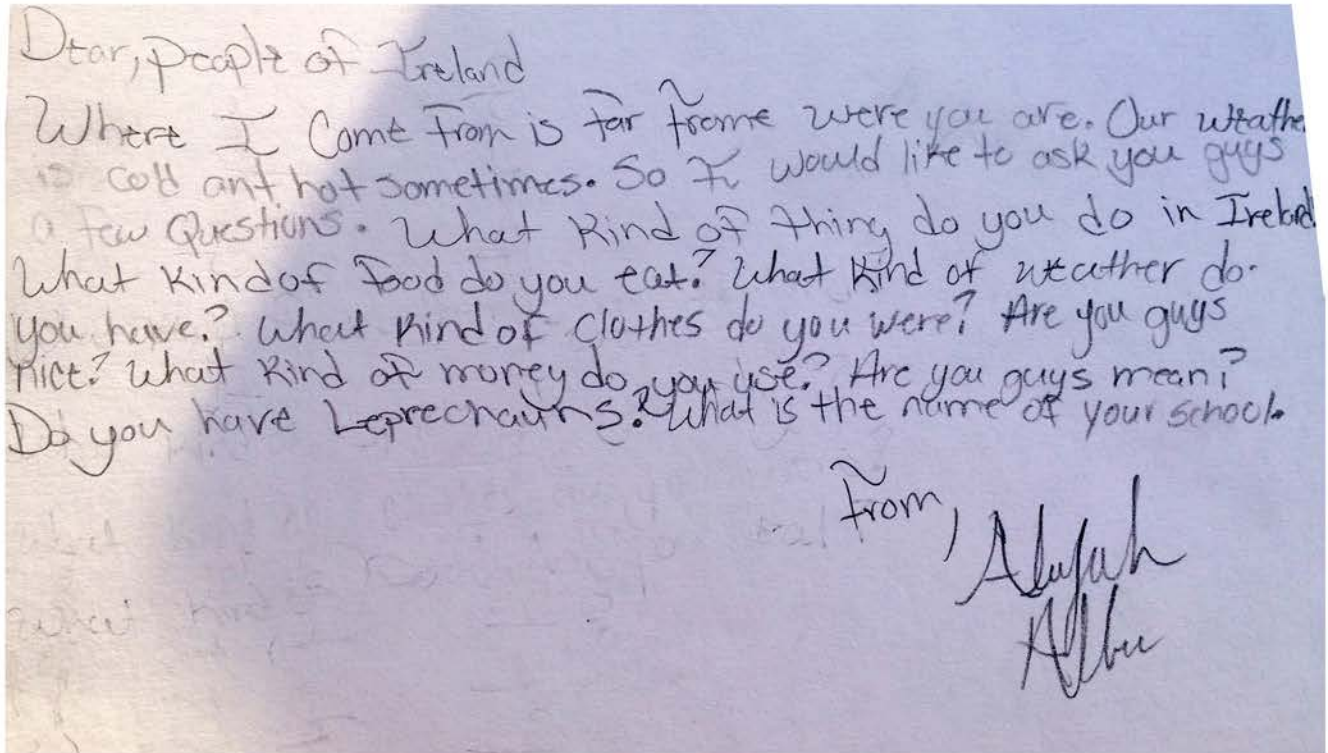


57 MILES

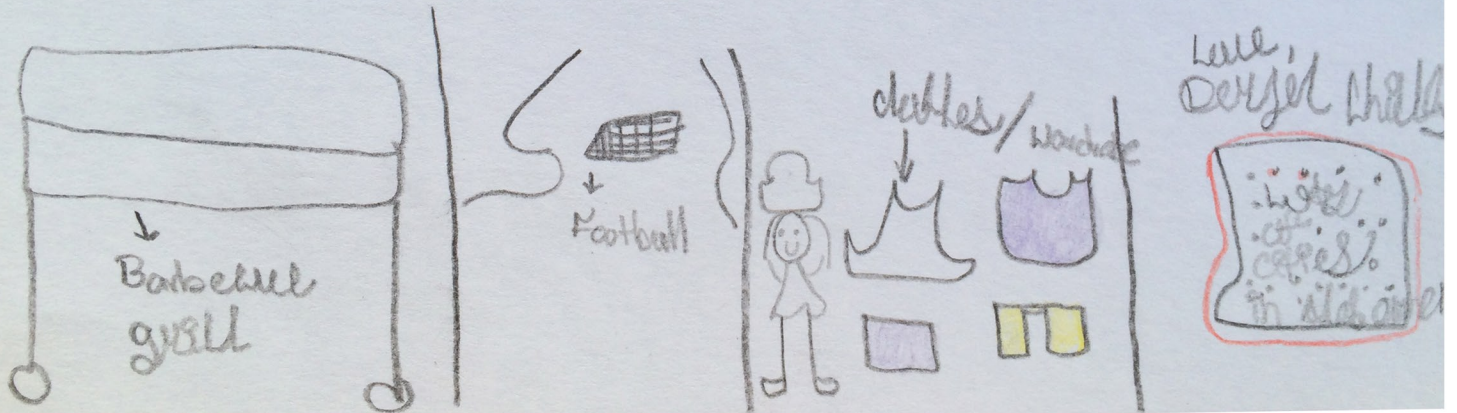

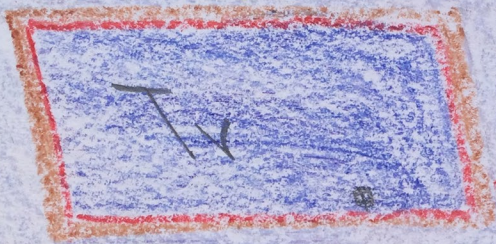
Dear, Irish
